FULLY FUNDED **SUMMER** SCHOLARSHIPS

Dunbar and East Linton Area Partnership is starting something new this summer.

The Partnership, promoted and supported by East Lothian Council, is offering a limited number of fully funded summer courses to children aged between 8 and 15 between 3rd July and 11th August 2017. All first stage applicants were successful, and Award letters will shortly be on their way.

Who can apply for the Summer School?

The free courses are being offered to children aged 8 -15 yrs who are resident within the school catchment areas of Dunbar, East Linton, Stenton, Spott and Innerwick who want to learn something new over the holiday period.

It is anticipated that notification of places will be made to successful applicants by the end of May 2017.



Fully funded Scholarship Courses will run throughout the summer and absolutely no previous experience is required for any of them – just a commitment to join in to learn something new and a willingness to tell us about it afterwards. The course providers this year are:

Coast to Coast Surf School (for ages 8 to 15)

This is a four-day course running from Monday to Thursday inclusive with morning and afternoon sessions. Breakfast, a packed lunch and two snacks will be provided as well as transport to and from the Bleachingfield Centre, Dunbar. Children will be collected from Bleachingfield at 10am for transporting to the surf school before returning back to Bleachingfield around 4pm. All equipment will be provided and children will simply need enthusiasm, swimming gear, a change of clothes and perhaps a hot drink! Please also note that children must be able to swim 50m unaided in a swimming pool to take part in this course.

Fox Lake Adventures (for ages 8 to 15)

This is a four-day, morning only, course running from Monday to Thursday inclusive for adventurous early birds. Children will be collected from Bleachingfield at 7.30am for a swift ride to Fox Lake for breakfast. From 8.30 – 1.30pm during the course they will experience low ropes, mini adventures, wakeboarding and a whole lot more – all outdoors in a safe and secure environment. After lunch on site, children will be returned to Bleachingfield.

Dunbar Fashion School (for ages 8 to 15)

This is a four and a half-day course that will introduce children to all aspects of fashion design and manufacture. The course runs from 10am to 3pm Monday to Thursday and 10am to 12pm Friday. Children will be given the chance to design and make a garment to take home at the end of the week. Breakfast and lunch will be provided at the Bleachingfield Centre as well as refreshment at the Fashion School.
