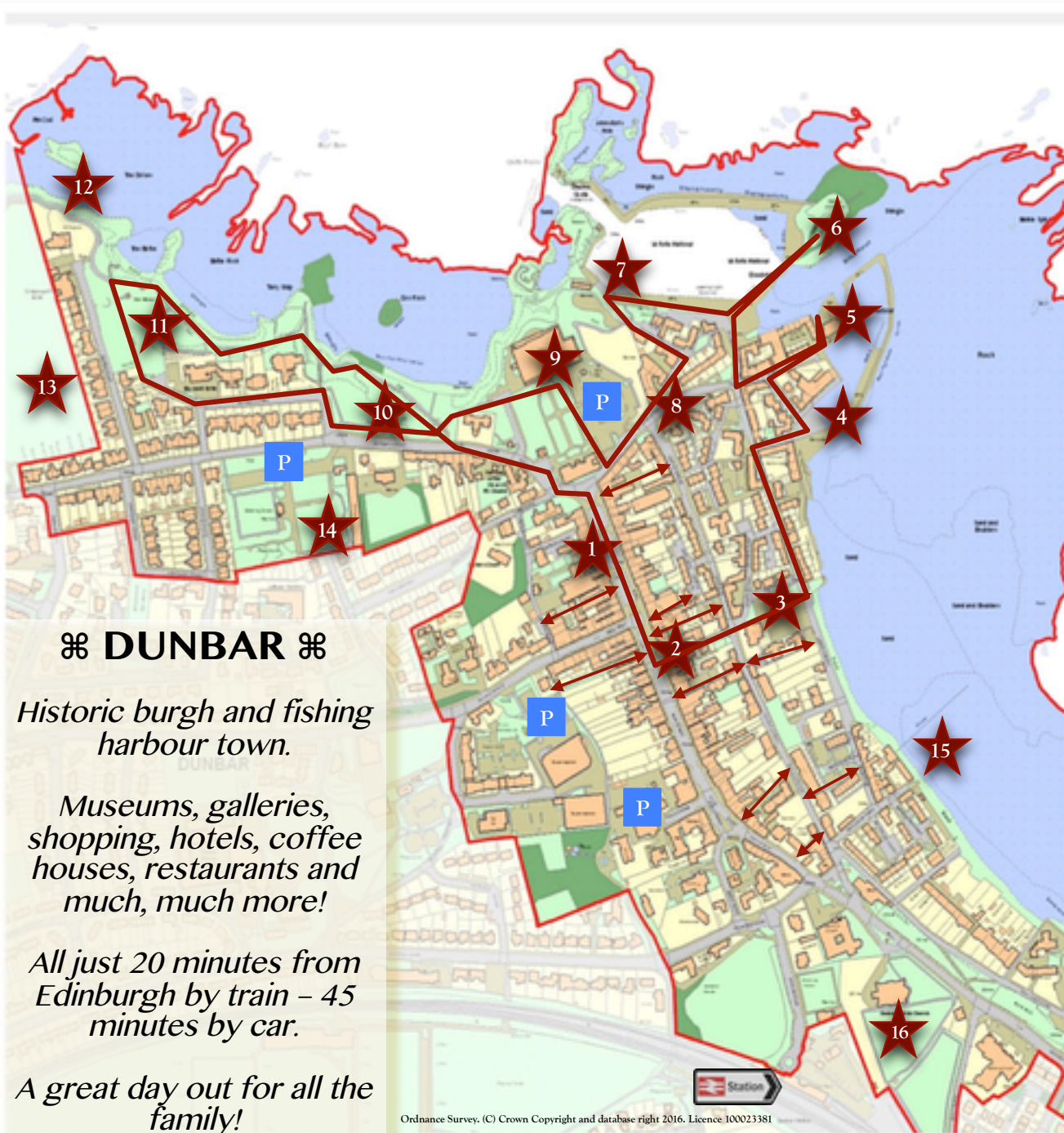
Wandering Tour of DUNBAR

- 1 **John Muir's Birthplace Museum – High Street**
Free interactive museum and Tourist Information
- 2 **Dunbar Town House**
Free museum and gallery, Dunbar and District History Society, statue of John Muir as a boy
- 3 **Children's Play Garden**
Play equipment, access to Dunbar East Beach, rockpooling
- 4 **Cromwell Harbour**
Historic harbour walls, telescope, history panels, fishing boats, Fishermen's Monument
- 5 **McArthur's Store**
Historic granary building and local history panels
- 6 **The Battery on Lamer Island**
Historic hospital site, gun emplacement and look out
- 7 **Victoria Harbour**
Dunbar Castle ruins, kittiwakes, seals, fishing and leisure boats, RNLI station, Robert Wilson propeller, nature and history panels, Sir Basil Spence designed fishermen's housing
- 8 **Victoria Street (Cat's Row) & Creel Loaders Statue**
Sir Basil Spence designed fishermen's cottages, Creel Loaders statue, history panels, Scotland's oldest Methodist Church
- 9 **Dunbar Leisure Pool and grounds**
Lauderdale House, history panels, Swan Girl sculpture, parade ground, harbour views, pool with wave machine and flume
- 10 **The Glebe**
Military gun emplacement, castle and sea views, access to coastal trail
- 11 **War Memorial**
Access to coastal trail, castle and coastal views
- 12 **Coastal Promenade**
Cliff-top pathway towards Belhaven Bay
- 13 **Winterfield Park**
Tennis, free putting green, exercise course, access to coastal path
- 14 **Lauderdale Park**
Walled garden, children's play areas and seasonal café
- 15 **East Beach and East Links**
Sandy and rocky foreshores
- 16 **Dunbar Parish Church and Churchyard**
History panel and historic churchyard

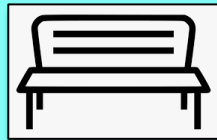

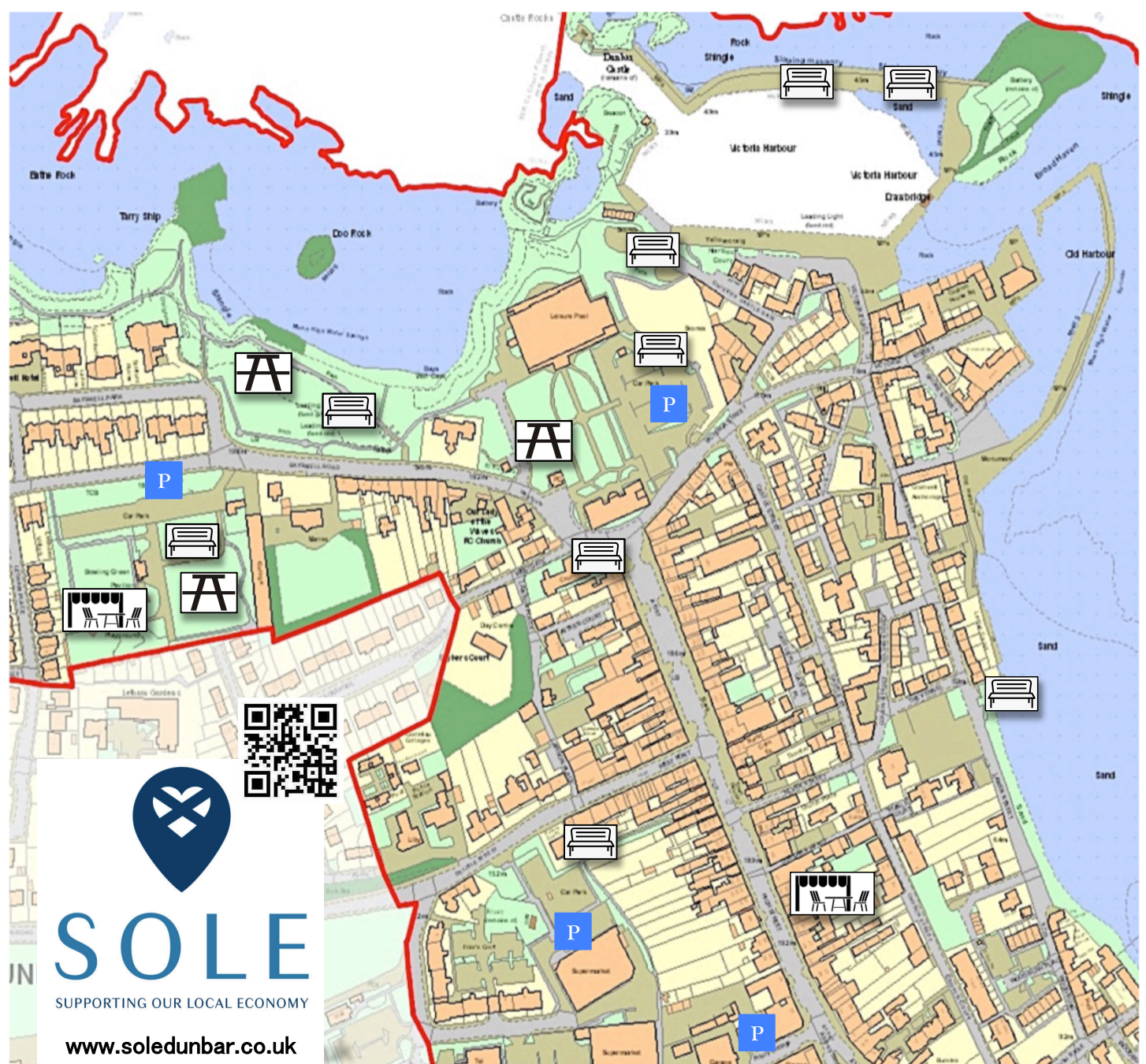
