Independent Examiner's Report to Dunbar Community Council

I report on the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2025 which are set out on pages 3 to 6

Respective responsibilities of the Community Council and the examiner

The Community Council is responsible for the preparation of the accounts.

It is my responsibility to examine the accounts and to state what particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the Community Council and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanation from the Community Council concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.
